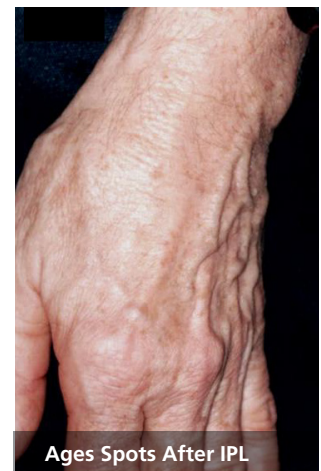


## Say goodbye to sun spots, red marks, and facial flushing.

With Intense Pulse Light (IPL) therapy, you can drastically improve the appearance of your skin with little or no downtime. In as few as three treatments, patients report noticeably smoother and more even skin—many claiming as much as 90 percent improvement.

# Frequently Asked Questions

## How does IPL work?

IPL combats the effects of aging and damaged skin by delivering gentle pulses of “light” to targeted surfaces. Quick and effective, IPL rejuvenates skin to stimulate the production of collagen and causes problem spots to disappear naturally.

## What can I expect?

IPL is administered in 15-30 minute sessions, with treatments as often as every three weeks. Before treatment, targeted areas are cleansed and covered with a soothing gel. After treatment, a cool compress is applied for maximum comfort. While IPL provides an unfamiliar sensation for most (many compare it with the snap of rubber band), the process is quick and the discomfort is minimal.

## How many treatments will I need?

For optimal results, a series of five IPL treatments are recommended. While many patients see significant improvements after two to three sessions, others may require more. To maintain results, follow up treatments may be desired annually.

## Are there any side effects?

After treatments, your face may appear red or flushed and brown areas may temporarily become darker. In most cases, the redness will disappear within a few hours and darkened areas will flake off within 7-

10 days. Makeup may be applied immediately after IPL so no downtime is required. Between sessions, vibradermabrasion or microdermabrasion may be used to enhance results and improve recovery.

Rarely, some individuals may experience temporary swelling and/or blistering. Limiting sun exposure before and after treatment will greatly reduce your risk of complications.

## What results will I see?

Most patients report a high satisfaction rate with the results of IPL sighting a 70 to 90 percent improvement in the quality of their skin. Within as little as three treatments, you should notice a visible improvement in your skin’s texture and tone.

## IPL and Rosacea

Rosacea, characterized by redness or a flushing on the face, is a common skin condition affecting as many as 14 million Americans. While the exact cause of Rosacea is unknown, frequent sun exposure, alcohol, medications, and stress may be contributing factors. IPL can control the symptoms of Rosacea and, in many cases, may decrease the need for antibiotics or topical cortisone creams.
